NOTE: NDUS Procedure 460.4, the Academic Affairs Council has adopted the following guidelines for minimum AP, CLEP, IB, and DSST examination scores. The NDUS no longer accepts the CLEP General Examinations. The required minimum credit-granting scores, number of semester hours of credit to be granted, and specific course equivalents are listed in the following tables. See the bottom of the chart for special consideration for scores of 4 or 5.

- ¹ Credit should not be granted for PHYS 110. Credit for lab experience may be awarded, based on student experience.
- ² Prior to 2002, Student Art: Drawing I received credit for Drawing 130 and Drawing 230.
- ³ Or equivalent on-campus course
- ⁴ Three credit hours in MUSC 122 & MUSC 123 are awarded for a subscore of 3 or higher on either portion of the AP Music Theory examination.
- ⁵ Four or five credit hours are awarded for a subscore of 3 or higher on the Calculus AB portion of the AP Calculus BC examination.
